NOTE: Leadership roles *begin* on January 1 of the year following the charge conference where elected.

Those committees with classes (i.e. 2022, 2023, 2024 etc.) are three-year terms; the year signifies the last year of the term. Ex: class of 2022 has served 2 years and will complete their term (third year) on December 31, 2022. And so on. All other positions are ONE-year terms.

¶247.7 The charge conference may establish a limit to consecutive terms of office for any and all elected or appointed officers, except where otherwise mandated. *It is recommended that no officer shall serve more than 3 consecutive years.*
