



Greetings! Due to the current weather forecast, we will begin **Outdoor Worship** on **May 2** (weather permitting) at 10:30 am. When outdoor worship begins, the service will still be live-streamed for those who wish to worship at home. **In the event of inclement weather, the worship service will be live-streamed only.** Notice of cancellation may be made through Calling Post, Facebook and/or email. Please do not call the church on Sunday mornings to inquire; no one is available to answer the phones.

Things to Remember for Outdoor Worship beginning May 2 (weather permitting):

- ♥ When you come, be sure to check in at the welcome table. This will help us keep good attendance records and contact tracing.
- ♥ Bring your seat (chair, blanket, etc.); no seating will be provided. Bring something to drink if you wish. Please do not sit in the worship team's area or on the front driveway as it impedes traffic flow.
- ♥ Dress for the weather.
- ♥ Wearing a mask or facial covering is required. If you forget your mask, extra masks are available at the welcome table. Hand sanitizers stations are available, too.
- ♥ Stay 6 feet apart from others. Families that occupy the same household may sit together.
- ♥ Air hugs, waves, signs of peace, nods, bows, or placing your hand over your heart, all from a 6' distance, are alternate ways to greet one another. *Please refrain from hugs, handshakes, fist/elbow bumps, etc.*
- ♥ The building will be closed except for the handicapped bathroom. Sanitizing wipes are available in the bathroom to wipe down the facility after use.
- ♥ The weekly bulletin is posted on our website: www.stpaulumcwillingboro.com. A link will also be on the Facebook chat.
- ♥ The service will be live-streamed at 10:30 am for those who wish to worship from home.
- ♥ Please stay home if you are not feeling well, have symptoms of Covid-19 (high fever, cough, etc.) or have recently been around someone with Covid-19. See notice on travel guidelines below.

People who are fully vaccinated with an FDA-authorized vaccine and persons who clinically recovered from COVID-19 in the past 3 months who are traveling domestically within the United States do not need to be tested for COVID-19 before or after travel to New Jersey and do not need to self-quarantine upon return. Unvaccinated travelers and residents returning from any U.S. state or territory beyond the immediate region (New York, Connecticut, Pennsylvania, and Delaware) should self-quarantine at their home, hotel, or other temporary lodging following Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommendations for unvaccinated people.

- ♥ Remember that we are still in the midst of the Covid-19 pandemic so we will continue to follow CDC, state and conference guidelines for worship. Our goal is to ensure no one contracts the virus due to any UMC event.
